AN ORDINANCE TO LOWER THE TOTAL GALLONS USED FOR THE MINIMUM WATER AND SEWER BILLING

WHEREAS, the City of Portland deems it necessary to increase revenue to cover additional operating and capital expenses for water and sewer; and


WHEREAS, the current rate structure for water and sewer has the minimum bill based upon 0-2,500 gallons per month for all rate classes; and

WHEREAS, the minimum bill for all rate classes shall be amended to 0-2,000 gallons per month; and


WHEREAS, all other rates established by Ordinance 22-77 shall remain unchanged and in full effect; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Portland that the minimum bill for water and sewer shall be revised to 0-2,000 gallons per month as stated above beginning January 1, 2025; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
