**AN ORDINANCE TO LOWER THE TOTAL GALLONS USED FOR THE MINIMUM WATER AND SEWER BILLING**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Portland deems it necessary to increase revenue to cover additional operating and capital expenses for water and sewer; and


**WHEREAS**, the current rate structure for water and sewer has the minimum bill based upon 0-2,500 gallons per month for all rate classes; and


**WHEREAS**, the minimum bill for all rate classes shall be amended to 0-2,000 gallons per month; and

**WHEREAS**, all other rates established by Ordinance 22-77 shall remain unchanged and in full effect; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Portland that the minimum bill for water and sewer shall be revised to 0-2,000 gallons per month as stated above beginning January 1, 2025; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that this Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
